Re: Proposal to Reissue and Modify Nationwide Permits

Comment Deadline Extension Request

Dear Mr. Olsen:

The American Exploration & Production Council ("AXPC") and the Independent Petroleum Association of America ("IPAA") were pleased to see the publication of the *Proposal to Reissue* and Modify Nationvide Permits ("Proposal") in the federal register on June 1, 2016, (Volume 81, Number 105) and respectfully request a 60-day extension to the comment deadline provided in the notice.

While AXPC and IPAA understand the desire of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ("USACE") to advance the public process, as the 2012 Nationwide Permits expire on March 18, 2017, AXPC and IPAA believe that in order to adequately address how, "the 2015 revisions to the definition of 'waters of the United States' might affect the applicability and efficiency of the proposed [Nationwide Permits] NWPs," AXPC and IPAA need additional time for their members to thoughtfully consider and respond to this proposed rulemaking. Further, USACE is seeking comment on several additional topics including, "whether to retain the ½-acre limit that has been imposed on certain NWPs," and, "on whether the [Pre-Construction Notification] PCN thresholds for specific NWPs should be changed to improve the efficiency of the NWP Program while maintaining strong protection of the aquatic environment." Other items requiring review include the USACE draft National Environmental Policy Act decision documents and the USACE District Office's regional conditions. The breadth and depth of these issues for which USACE is seeking comment requires more than the allotted 60-day comment period to meaningfully supply USACE with the information it seeks from public commenters.

AXPC and IPAA look forward to participating in this important public process and appreciate USACE's consideration on this 60-day comment extension request to insure it is provided with meaningful and practical comments.
