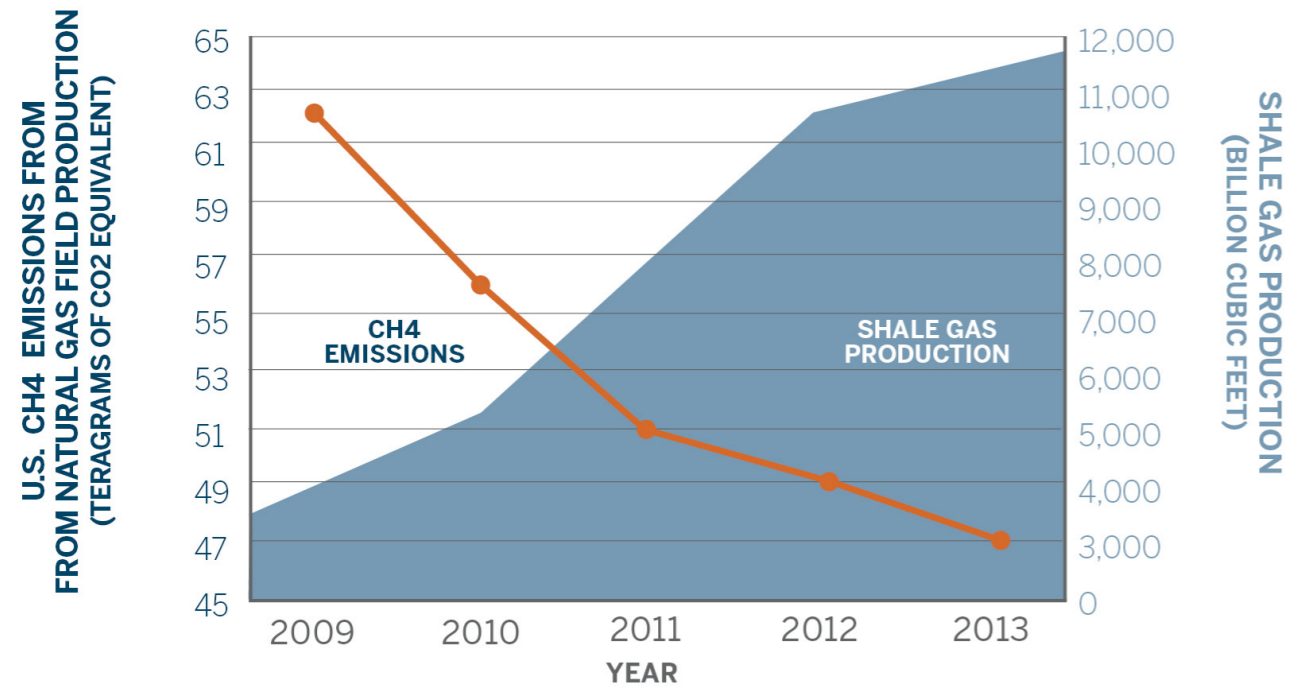


Shale Gas Production is Up, Methane Emissions are Down



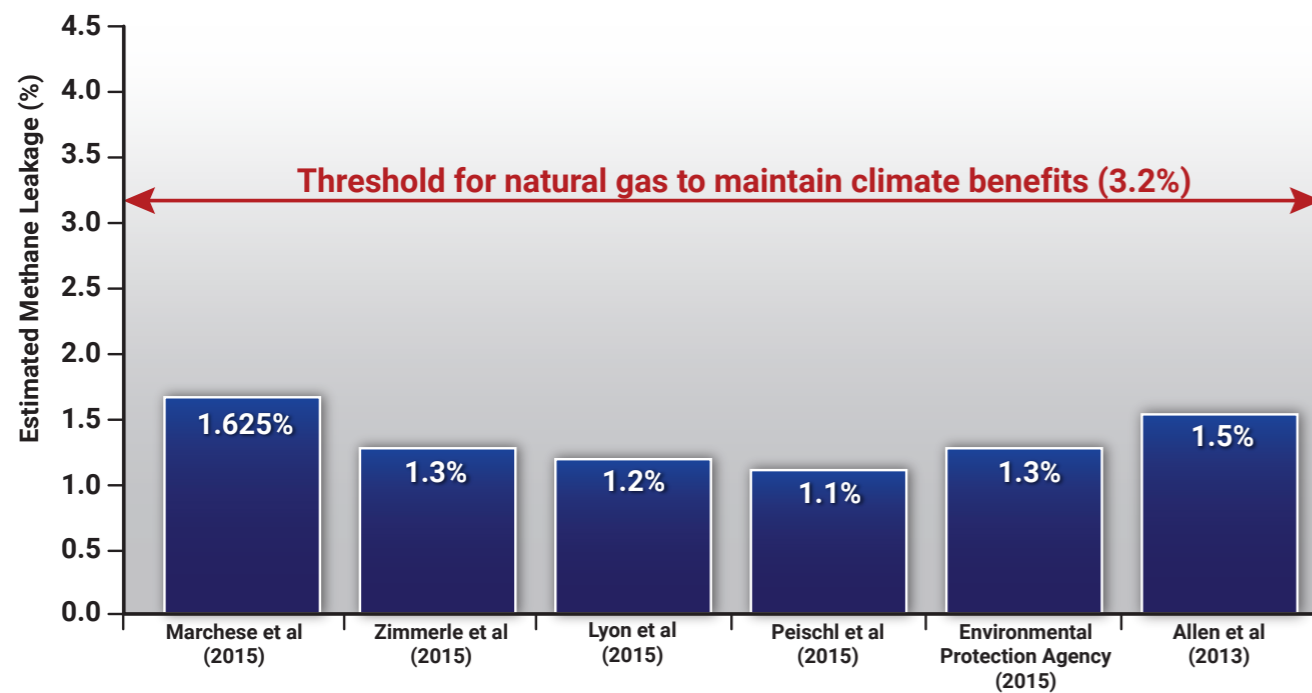

Methane Emissions from Oil and Natural Gas Exploration and Production

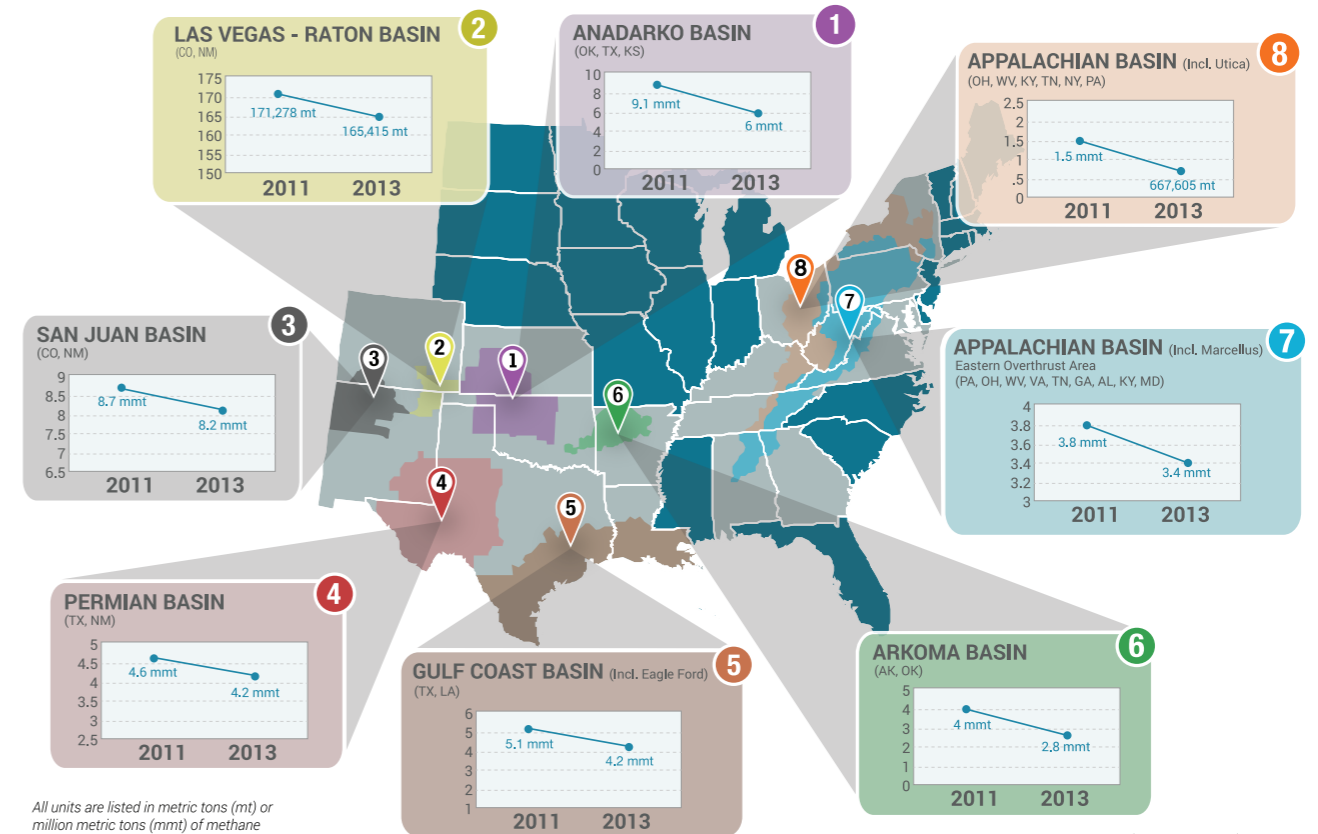
