Provides capital to take the company to the "next level"	Relative maturity of the company
Continued exposure to the macro environment	Receptivity of the equity markets
Currency for continued growth	Volatility of equity markets
Liquid currency for shareholders	Filing / reporting requirements





An IPO Is A Financing

- Should not be viewed as an "exit"
- Pre-IPO insiders likely to hold a significant equity stake post-IPO
- Organizational understanding of this concept vital to success
- Manage float / trading liquidity and secondary shares
