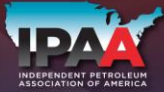

Matt McCarroll

Founder, President & CEO

Matt McCarroll is the Founder, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Fieldwood Energy Inc., a Houston-based company focused on the acquisition and development of oil and gas assets in the Gulf of Mexico and on the Gulf Coast. Fieldwood is currently the 5th largest producer in the Gulf of Mexico (GOM) and is also one of the largest privately-owned exploration and production companies in the United States. Fieldwood has grown rapidly since its founding in 2013, both organically and through a series of significant acquisitions, including Noble Energy's entire deepwater GOM portfolio for \$480 million in 2018, SandRidge's GOM and Gulf Coast business in 2014, and Apache's GOM Shelf assets for \$3.75 billion in 2013.

Fieldwood operates production exceeding 130,000 BOE per day and employs approximately 3,200 full-time staff and offshore contract personnel. In addition to its U.S. operations, in 2016 the Company was awarded a production sharing contract from the Mexican government to develop two fields in the shallow water Mexican Gulf of Mexico and is the first U.S. Company to successfully drill and establish production offshore Mexico in over 75 years.

Prior to Fieldwood, Mr. McCarroll was the Founder and CEO of Dynamic Offshore Resources, LLC, which became one of the largest operators on the Gulf of Mexico Shelf from its inception in 2008 until its sale to SandRidge Energy in 2012 for approximately \$1.3 billion. Prior to Dynamic, Mr. McCarroll was President of Maritech Resources, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of TETRA Technologies, Inc. Mr. McCarroll was an original member of the senior management team of Plains Resources, Inc., holding several management positions including Vice President of Land and Exploration. Early in his career he also held positions with Great Southern Oil and Gas and Amoco Production Company.

Mr. McCarroll holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and Finance from Louisiana State University. He is a member of The Dean's Advisory Council of the E.J. Ourso College of Business at Louisiana State University and in 2015 was inducted to the college's Hall of Distinction.

Mr. McCarroll currently serves as a Director of Dynamic Energy Services International, a fabrication, construction, and maintenance contractor serving the global energy industry and of Remington Outdoor Company, the oldest gun maker in the United States. He is an active member in numerous industry associations and serves on the Executive Committee of the National Ocean Industries Association (NOIA).
