The American Petroleum Institute (API) is one of the largest advocates for the industry. It recently released an "Economic Impact Study" that evaluates the impact of oil and natural gas in states and localities. This new study can be used as an important tool for the E&P sector to educate the public and policymakers on the importance of energy production. The American Gas Association (AGA), representing natural gas utilities, is facing a barrage of bad policies that restrict consumer energy choice. Politicians at the federal, state and local levels have introduced legislation and regulation to ban new natural gas appliances, such as stoves and water heaters, as well as new natural gas connections for homes and buildings. AGA is at the forefront of fighting these misguided policies and is educating policymakers and consumers about the importance of clean, reliable, affordable American natural gas
